The program

This course examines the Safety Officer's role at emergency situations. The focus will be on operations within the Incident Management System. Persons attending this course should have a working knowledge of the IMS, building construction principles and applicable NFPA guidelines. The students will be able to identify and analyze safety concerns as they relate to all hazards scene evaluation and communicate recommended solutions to the Incident Commander. Through a review of firefighter fatality and injury data and basic risk management principles, the student will increase their skills as a potential Incident Safety Officer.

Daniel B.C. Gardiner is the retired Fire Chief of the Department of Fire-Rescue Services in Fairfield, CT, serving there for 31 years.
