Groups must designate one spokesperson to speak on behalf of the group. If you wish to address an item already on the agenda, please wait until that item is announced. The Fire District Board is not permitted to discuss or take action on any item raised in the call to the public. However, individual Board Members may be permitted to respond to criticism directed to them. Otherwise, the Board may direct that staff review the matter or that the matter be placed on a future agenda. The Fire District Board cannot discuss or take legal action on any issue raised during the call to the public due to restrictions of the Open Meeting Law.

6. **REPORTS**: The governing body may not propose, discuss, deliberate or take legal action on these matters unless the specific matter is properly identified on the agenda. Therefore, action taken as a result of these Reports will be limited to directing staff to study the matter or scheduling the matter for further consideration and decision at a later date.
