Governing Board meeting minutes. Chief Moore advised the Board the following:

No changes have been made to our current operational directives regarding COVID-19.

We are currently waiting on funding action from the State for special taxing districts.

The Department of Forestry will be sending out renewals for the Cooperative Fire Rate Agreement (CFRA), this agreement provides the pay rate for our off district wildland assignments.

Tower inspections are tentative to take place in January 2022.

Bullhead City Fire District will celebrate its 75<sup>th</sup> Birthday in 2022, a committee has been assembled to work on a challenge coin and signage for the for the occasion.

The District 6 ambulance that has been funded in part by the community block development grant (CBDG) will be shipped to the vendor December 15.

Medic unit 731 has been repaired and returned to service.

Work continues on the ISO re-rate for early 2022.

The leadership series is scheduled for late February/early March 2022; a syllabus was attached to the board packet.

Chief Moore provided monthly stats which are attached.

Chief Neal gave a brief report on Logistics and Facilities: The warehouse at station #2 electrical and plumbing is near completion.

The Station 5 Solar project is still in the installation phase.

Station #7 update, Seabury Fritz Architects (SFA) is contracted to begin design development on the Laughlin Ranch Station #7.

#### **BUSINESS**

AIA Document A133-2019 between Owner and Construction Manager as Constructor GMP. Chief Neal addressed the Board, he explained GMP agreement with exhibits between Willmeng Construction and the Bullhead City Fire District. He added that both Willmeng and the Fire Districts attorneys have vetted the documents and the contract is now ready for signatures. After a brief discussion Board Member Brummett made a motion to approve the GMP contract with Willmeng Construction as presented, Board Member Flenniken seconded the motion, all were in favor and the motion carried unanimously.
