- 5. JPA feasibility study and education to participating districts continues. We expect the study to be complete in 30-45 days.
- 6. Policy revisions will be presented to the Board for approval at the November meeting.
- 7. Staff continue to work with Exceptional Community Hospital. This is a new hospital opening soon in BHC.
- 8. Personnel completed a controlled burn on a city owned property near the river.
- 9. PFFA/AFDA/AFCA nothing to report.
- 10. Training-two personnel attended an Arson Investigation Level 3 Class.
- 11. Updates on Grants.
- 12. Auditing Firm was on site this week, we anticipate the FY 22/23 Audit to be presented in person in early 2024.
- 13. AFDA- Winter conference scheduled in January.
- 14. Pulse Point update, currently suspended.
