QUALIFICATIONS FOR PARTICIPATION

In order to be eligible as a Bullhead City Fire Department Firefighter, the following qualifications must be met:

- At least 18 years of age at time of application
- High school diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license in state of residency
- IFSAC Fire Fighter I & II or equivalency (AZ Fire I & II)
- National Registry or Arizona EMCT-EMT or EMCT-Paramedic certification
- Current CPR Healthcare provider certification
- ACLS & PALS (Paramedics only)

SELECTION PROCESS

- Application and Resume (**can be** accepted electronically)
- Proof of vaccinations and medical physical within previous 12 months (routine physical)
- TPT Physical Agility Evaluation
- Successful completion of National Testing Network (NTN) FireTEAM entry level test within previous 12 months **or** a minimum of 12 months work experience at a PSPRS organization
- Oral Board Interview
- Fire Chief's Interview

NATIONAL TESTING NETWORK (NTN) INFORMATION

What to expect at the www.nationaltestingnetwork.com website

- Detailed information about the testing process for both the entry level test and CPAT testing
- Opportunity to take online practice tests at www.fireteamtest.com
- Schedule your own convenient test time. Tests are offered multiple times a week, including Saturday's.
- Take high quality job simulation tests in a standardized, fair testing environment.

Upon completion of the entry level exam and CPAT testing, all candidates' scores are automatically forwarded to the Bullhead City Fire Department. Candidates who obtain a passing score on both the entry level exam and the physical abilities test will be placed on the eligibility list to be provided by NTN. Bullhead City Fire Department may contact candidates on the NTN list and may invite them to continue to participate in other stages of the department's selection process.

National Testing Network is a service provided to conduct entry level testing and CPAT testing in a standardized, professional environment. National Testing Network does not replace the Bullhead City Fire Department's responsibility and decision making in the testing process. All candidate results are provided to Bullhead City Fire Department. Final decisions will be made by Bullhead City Fire Department.
