Qualifications:

In order to be eligible as a Bullhead City Fire Department reserve firefighter, the following qualifications must be met:

- At least 18 years of age at time of application
- High School Diploma or GED
- Valid driver's license in state of residency
- IFSAC Fire Fighter I & II or equivalency
- National Registry or Arizona Basic EMCT Certification

Selection Process:

- Application & Resume
- Proof of vaccinations and medical physical within previous 12 months (routine physical)
- CPAT certification within previous 12 months
- Successful completion of National Testing Network (NTN) FireTEAM entry level test (70% passing) within previous 12 months
- Oral Interview

- Opportunity to take online practice tests at www.fireteamtest.com.
- Schedule your own convenient test time. Tests are offered multiples times a week, including Saturdays.
- Take high quality job simulation tests in a standardized, fair testing environment

Upon completion of the entry level exam and CPAT testing, all candidate scores are automatically forwarded to the Bullhead City Fire Department. Candidates who attain a passing score on both the entry level exam and the physical abilities test will be placed on the eligibility list to be provided by NTN. Bullhead City Fire Department may contact candidates on the NTN list and may invite them to continue to participate in other stages of the department's selection process.

National Testing Network is a service provided to conduct entry level testing and CPAT testing in a standardized, professional environment. National Testing Network does not replace the Bullhead City Fire Department's responsibility and decision making in the testing process. All candidate results are provided to Bullhead City Fire Department. Final decisions will be made by Bullhead City Fire Department.
